The Buffalo Fire Appliance Co. demonstrated a 500-gallon pumper on December 28, 1930.

In 1932 the new Buffalo Pumper was placed in service. It had a 500-gpm rotary gear pump with a 150-gallon water tank.

The 1932 Buffalo Engine replaced the 1922 Childs-Reo Pumper.

On November 1, 1963, after the purchase of a new ladder truck, the Buffalo Pumper was sold to Seward "Poss" Mellon. Bids opened show that the high bid was for \$377.00.
