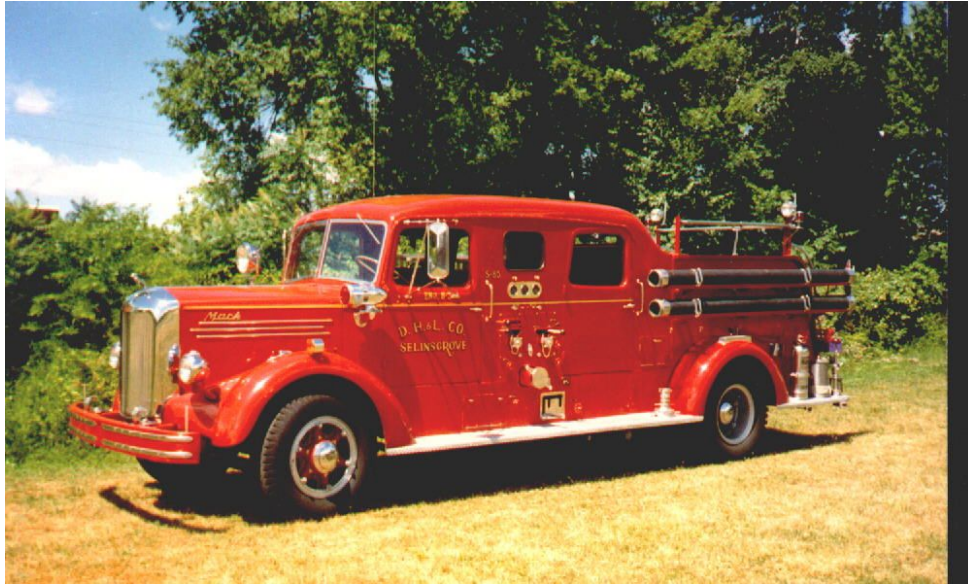


1948 MACK



On December 1, 1948 the Hookies received their new Mack L-85 Sedan Cab Pumper at an original cost of \$15,218.75. It is powered by a Mack ENF707A, 707 cubic inch motor with dual ignition and a 4-speed transmission. The pump is a 750 gpm Hale ZD with a 300-gallon booster tank. The wheelbase is 182" and the gross weight is 20,200 lbs.

The Mack answered its last fire call on May 17, 1987. Upon purchase of a 1988 Hahn Pumper in November 1987, the Mack was sold for \$3000 to Mack Fire Apparatus Buff Harvey Eckart of Berwick, PA. In September 2002 Mr. Eckart sold the Mack to Gary Thurston of Syracuse, NY.
