

## 1963 SEAGRAVE AERIAL



The 1963 Seagrave Aerial has a 5 man open cab and was powered by a Seagrave V12 - 240 HP gasoline engine. It also came with hydraulic brakes. It was, in later years, fitted with a diesel engine and air brakes. The aerial has a 75' tip, a 750-gpm pump and carries 300 gallons of water. It was delivered on October 22, 1963 at a cost of over \$41,000.

The hose reel was removed and a 2 ½" line was installed for pre-connected lines. The hose reel was installed on the 1953 Tanker.

The 1963 Seagrave Aerial replaced both the 1925 Hahn Ladder Truck and the 1932 Buffalo Pumper. It was sold in the fall of 1998 to fire apparatus collector Bob Sutcliffe of Orangeville, PA for \$3500.
