

1970 HAHN ENGINE



The Hahn was purchased in October 1970 for \$38,000. This was the next to last piece of fire apparatus off the line before the Hahn plant in Pennsylvania closed. It has a 5-man cab and is powered by a 549 cubic inch engine. It carries 1000 gallons of water and has a 1000 gpm pump. The Hahn was equipped with all necessary firefighting equipment.

The Hahn was sold to the Freeburg Fire Co. of Freeburg, PA for \$1000 in the fall of 1998. During the summer of 2003 the Freeburg Fire Co. donated the 1970 Hahn to the Upper Augusta Fire Dept., Northumberland Co., Pennsylvania.
