

1976 RESCUE



The Rescue is a 1976 chassis that was a former Pennsylvania Power and Light service vehicle. The current box was placed in 1987. This unit was purchased from the Mahanoy City Fire Department for \$12,500 in the fall of 1999. Approximately \$40,000 was spent to refurbish the rescue prior to putting it in service in 2000. It has a 3-man cab, an onboard 7.5kw generator and seating capacity for 6 in the rear. The rear also has radio capabilities for use as a command center. Among its equipment are a cascade system, a Lukas vehicle rescue tool, oxygen, forcible entry tools, air bags, spare air bottles and a wide assortment of other rescue and firefighting equipment. The Rescue replaced the 1976 Utility van. This unit was taken out of service on July 10, 2003. It was donated to the Port Trevorton Fire Company in early 2004.
