

1976 TANKER



The Tanker, purchased and placed in service in 1989, is a converted milk truck and has a 2000 gal capacity tank with a 1000 gpm pump mounted on the front bumper. It also has a quick dump on the rear. It carries a 3500 gallon dump tank and is equipped with two 1 ½" hand lines. The 3-man cab is on a chassis powered by a 366 cubic inch gasoline engine, a 5-speed transmission and a 2-speed rear-end. The hose reel in the side compartment, which was original equipment on the 1963 Seagrave Aerial, was transferred from the 1953 Tanker. The 1976 Tanker replaced the 1953 GMC Tanker. The 1976 Tanker was taken off the road at the end of October 2005 due to mechanical and structural problems and was officially taken out of service on December 12, 2005 when it was sold for \$1500 to Charles Paige for use at the Selinsgrove Speedway as a water truck.
