

1976 CHEVY UTILITY TRUCK



The Utility Truck, placed in service in March 1980, was a refurbished service truck that was purchased from a local housing company and refurbished at a total cost of \$5358.00. Sponsors for the refurbishing were Selingsrove Boro, Penn Township, Zimmer Homes, V.L. Seibold Funeral Home and William Moffatt Carpet. It was equipped with a cascade system, a Hurst vehicle rescue tool and a multitude of additional firefighting and rescue equipment.

The 1976 Utility Van replaced the Equipment Truck that was purchased by the Junior Firefighters. It was sold in April 2000 to Ken Smith of Freeburg, PA.
