

1985 BRUSH TRUCK



The 1985 Chevrolet CK30 Brush Truck is a combination of two vehicles. The chassis was donated by the Pennsylvania State Forestry Service and the slide in unit was purchased from the Beaver Springs Fire Department for \$3000. The vehicle is 4 wheel drive and can carry 3 personnel. The Brush Truck is equipped with a 250 gallon water tank, a 300 gpm pump and 5 gallons of foam. It also carries 700' of forestry hose line, 200' of 1-3/4" and 50' of 2" hose. The Brush Truck carries 4 backpack water bladders, a leaf blower, chain saw, quartz lights, generator and cord reels. Other forest fire fighting equipment includes rakes, shovels and axes. The Brush Truck was placed in service on November 5, 2007.

The 1985 Chevrolet CK30 Brush Truck was taken out of service on March 25, 2013 and sold on April 10, 2013 to the United States Air Force Base in Cape Canaveral, Florida for \$16,900.00 including equipment and shipping. The unit left Selingsrove, PA on April 11, 2013 and arrived in Cape Canaveral, Florida on April 15, 2013
