

## 1997 CHEVROLET UTILITY



The Utility is a 1997 Chevy 3500 series pickup chassis with a 1997 Swab Wagon Company box. It is powered by an 8 cylinder, 6.5-liter fuel injected diesel turbo engine. This vehicle was used by the D.H.& L. Ambulance League for four years and was then sold to the Fire Company in 2001. Other major projects prevented this vehicle from being refurbished and placed in service until October 2003. Initially redesigned as a Dive Rescue unit, it later had other rescue gear on board for high angle and other rope rescue. The vehicle carries the personal water rescue gear for our divers as well as company owned gear. The utility is capable of carrying 6 persons. The unit can also be used for lighting and for the rehab of emergency personnel.

The 1997 Chevy 3500 Utility was taken out of service on October 29, 2013 and was sold for \$4000.00 on October 30, 2013 to the Panguitch Fire Department of Panguitch, Utah. The unit was picked up at our station and driven to Utah on November 14, 2013
