

1998 SEAGRAVE LADDER TRUCK



The Seagrave Ladder Truck was purchased and placed in service in the fall of 1998 for \$468,000. It has a 6-man cab and is powered by a series 60 – 450 horsepower Detroit Diesel engine and a 5-speed automatic transmission. It has a 100' aerial, carries 500 gallons of water and has a 1500 gpm pump. There are 4 pre-connected attack lines and 800' of 4" supply line and a 4" rear intake. Among its equipment is: 6 air packs, on board and portable lighting, a 7.5 kw generator, exhaust and ppv fans, ventilation saws, high angle rescue gear, stokes basket and first aid kit, assorted forcible entry tools, pike poles and six ladders including a 15' extension, two roof, attic, 24' and 35' extension.

The 1998 Seagrave replaced both the 1963 Seagrave Aerial and the 1970 Hahn Engine.
