

2005 INTERNATIONAL TANKER



On November 11, 2005 the Dauntless Hook and Ladder Co. Fire Department took delivery of a 2005 International 7400 Chassis with a 2007-gallon poly tank from 4Guys Inc. of Myersdale, PA. The Tanker was a demonstrator model purchased for \$173,000.

This is the Department's first Tanker that was built for use in the fire service. The International chassis is rated at 40,000 GVW and is powered by an International DT570 with 330 horsepower. It has a 205" wheelbase, is 26' 7" long, 8' 4" wide and 9' 5" high. The PTO driven pump is a 500 GPM Darley model HM500. The tank to pump valve is controlled by an electric switch. The pump is equipped with a 4-inch intake on each side as well as a 2-½ inch intake on the operator's side. There is one 2-½ inch discharge on each side of the pump as well as 2 to the rear. The tanker is equipped with three quick dumps for discharging its load, one located center rear and one each to the rear of each side of the vehicle. Controls for all quick dumps are located on both sides of the rear of the vehicle as well as in the cab. The tanker carries 100' of 4" and 100' of 2 ½" supply line. It carries 50' of trash line; 200' of forestry hose and 150' and 200' 1 ½ pre-connects. The tanker carries an assortment of rakes, shovels, axes, picks and several water cans.

The Tanker was placed in service on November 12, 2005.
